This course is designed for advanced exploration of scene study and acting technique with a special emphasis on the technical requirements of performing in film and television. Actors will learn to continuously work towards higher levels of truth in performance as well as develop the instincts required to make strong choices in the creation of a role. Each term will end with an "open class" so parents and families can observe the students performing on-camera as they would on a real working set.

Advanced Acting is a pre-requisite for Performance Class. In the Advanced program, students get to put their skills to the test. These courses are for serious students with extensive experience. Previous Studio training is an asset. Class projects are presented each term during the final class.
